

Chapter 94

INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Scott as indicated in article histories. Amendments noted where applicable.]

ARTICLE I

Provisional Operator's License

[Adopted 6-9-1988 by Ord. No. 1-1988]

§ 94-1. Issuance of license.

The Clerk may issue a provisional license to a person who has applied for an operator's license.

§ 94-2. Term of license.

The license is good for a period not to exceed 60 days, unless sooner revoked by the issuer, or until a regular license is issued.

§ 94-3. Standards.

All standards are the same as applying for an operator's license.

§ 94-4. Fee.¹

The fee for a provisional license is prescribed in the Town Fee Schedule. The current Town Fee Schedule is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

ARTICLE II

Cessation of Operations

[Adopted 7-11-2016 by Ord. No. 1-2016]

§ 94-5. Revocation of license.

Any licensee issued a license to sell alcohol beverages in the Town for which a quota exists limiting the number of such license that may be issued by the Town that fails to sell, serve, or provide alcohol beverages as permitted by such license for any period of 120 nonconsecutive days during the licensing year may have such license revoked by the Town Board for that reason, and the Town Board may decline to renew any such license for that reason.
